2010-2011 RECOMMENDED SLATE OF CANDIDATES

Secretary/Treasurer

Mary Anderson-Pickle, CGFO, Deputy Finance Administrator, City of Palm Beach Gardens

The candidate elected to this position will serve as President-elect, 2011-2012 and as President, 2012-2013

Director (three available positions)

The top two Director seats will be for a three-year term and the third seat will be for a one-year term.

Kent Olson, CGFO, Budget Officer, City of Jacksonville

Timothy Ray Pozza, CPA, CIA, CMA, Internal Audit Director, Okaloosa County CCC

Scott Simpson, CPA, CGFO, CPFO, CGFM, CPFA, CPFIM, CAPP, Chief Financial Officer, Department of Off-Street Parking, City of Miami

This is the proposed slate of candidates for 2010-2011; however, the ballot will not be finalized until March 12, 2010. Eligible members who do not appear on the above slate of candidates may petition the Nominating Committee for placement on the ballot. *All petitioned nominations must meet the minimum criteria stated in the FGFOA Policies and Procedures as revised November 18, 2009 which is available on the website at www.fgfoa.org.* The nomination and election procedures, which include the criteria for candidate eligibility and the requirements for a petition for candidacy, are available by contacting the FGFOA Administrative offices at (850) 222-9684. All petitions for candidacy, which are to include a candidate biography and picture, must be received (not postmarked) by the FGFOA office **no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 12, 2010**. The appropriate paperwork can be faxed to (850) 222-3806 or mailed to the FGFOA office at the above address.

Ballots will be available on March 23, 2010 to all Active Members of the Association. Membership must have been active for the 2009-2010 year in order to be eligible to vote.
