

RESOLUTION NO. 05-65

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SALARIED EMPLOYEES TO RECEIVE PAYMENT DURING A STATE OF EMERGENCY WHEN A LOCAL DECLARATION IS ESTABLISHED BY THE MAYOR, VICE MAYOR OR, IN THEIR ABSENCE, ANY OTHER ELECTED OFFICIAL.


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bradenton realizes that during emergency situation, the department heads, supervisors, and other salaried employees who are exempt under the Wage and Hour Law may be required to work beyond their normally scheduled hours;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA:


1. The payment of salaried employees who are required to work in excess of 40 hours in a work week during a state of emergency is authorized when a local declaration is established by the Mayor, Vice Mayor or, in their absence, any other elected official. The payment of salaried employees will only be for work performed that is a necessary emergency measure to protect life and property, to ensure effective operation of the City and other such work arising out of the state of emergency, including necessary post-incident activities.
2. During such state of emergency, the payment of salaried employees will be at the equivalent of their standard hourly rate of pay.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

PASSED AND DULY ADOPTED this 20th day of October, 2005.


